Some costly driver responsibility fees end

Some driver responsibility fees for lesser driving offenses have been eliminated. Secretary of State Ruth Johnson praised the elimination commenting, "Citizens already have to pay court fines and usually see higher insurance rates for violations. These extra fees have made things tougher for many families."

For the following violations, drivers will no longer have to pay the \$150 driver responsibility fee, previously charged for two consecutive years following the offense:

- Operating a motor vehicle with an expired operator's or chauffer's license
 - Operating without a valid license
 - Having more than one license
 - Failing to surrender licenses from other states

The new law also eliminated the \$200 driver responsibility fee (charged for two years following the offense) for:

- \bullet Failing to have mandatory motor vehicle insurance coverage
 - Failure to produce proof of insurance
- Knowingly providing false evidence of insurance

Drivers who owe these fees for offenses committed before October 1, 2012, will still be responsible for paying them.

Other driver responsibility fees of \$500 and \$1,000 for two consecutive years for a variety of more serious motor vehicle offenses, including alcohol-related, controlled substance and reckless driving violations, remain in place. •
