## Hitting A Home-Run For Heidi

Our own home-town hero Heidi L. Zellar was born in 1967 and graduated from Fruitport in 1985. She heard the Army's call to defend our nation. So, on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1985 she answered that call by taking a fearless step into the unknown. For 14 years, Staff Sergeant E-6 Zellar served our nation, tirelessly and honorably, by helping to preserve the American way of life.

Fifteen years after Heidi was discharged from the armed forces, she found herself taking another giant leap into the unknown. First, she lost a portion of her hand through cancer surgery, then she was diagnosed with a cerebral aneurysm, facing a possible stroke or brain damage.

Since the brain surgery, Heidi has not been able to work and she is now facing insurmountable bills from normal living expenses. The unpaid medical bills are even more horrific.

When she attended high school, she was enthralled with playing baseball. But now, this relatively young woman just wants to live. For her, even watching a ball game is a luxury.

We are asking the residents of Fruitport and the surrounding communities to step up to the plate and hit a home-run for Heidi by participating in a fundraiser for her. It's not asking a lot to help a selfless woman who defended a country full of Americans she never met.

Heidi was there when our nation needed help during the Gulf War conflict. Now it's our turn to help a veteran in need.
