Some of the features of Youth Day are the Hawg Trough, which is a 35 foot long aquarium mounted on a semi-trailer, stocked with local fish species, and acts as a stage for expert fishing speakers. Some other favorites are the rock climbing wall, birds of prey and reptile exhibits. There was a trout pond, where live trout were caught and then cleaned for the youth. There was also mentored shooting of firearms and archery equipment. Attendees also were able to experience various fire safety exhibits, demonstrations and tour fire trucks of all types as well as law enforcements displays.
