Youth Day is a free family friendly event to introduce our youth to the many activities that are available to them in the great outdoors. There were over 60 exhibitors on hand from 9am to 3pm. Some of the features of Youth Day are the Hawg Trough, which is a 35 foot long aquarium mounted on a semi-trailer, stocked with local fish species, and acts as a stage for expert fishing speakers. Some other favorites are the rock climbing wall, birds of prey and reptile exhibits. There was a trout pond, where live trout were caught and then cleaned for the youth. There was also mentored shooting of firearms and archery equipment.
