MADL Library for the Visually and Physically Disabled Nationally Recognized in Washington D.C.

Muskegon, MI - The Library for the Visually and Physically Disabled Branch of Muskegon Area District Library (MADL) has received the 2023 Sub-regional Library/ Advisory and Outreach Center of the Year Award from the Library of Congress National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled (NLS).

Sax Mahoney, Lead Librarian for the Library for the Visually and Physically Disabled Branch, and Ron Suszek, Director of MADL, accepted the award at a luncheon today [September 7] in the historic Thomas Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C.

MADL, one of nearly 100 libraries in the nationwide NLS network, serves more than 940 blind, physically disabled, and print disabled readers in Muskegon and Ottawa counties. In addition to circulating books and other materials in audio and braille, the library has an array of accessible technology on site for its patrons to use. Among its initiatives are a Senior Book Bin service, in which it delivers bins of large-print books to senior organizations each month, and Phone-A-Story, a dial-in service that has new recordings of poems, short stories, and children's stories each week.
