## **Financial Performance of the District and Annual Audit**

Fruitport Community Schools has once again received the highest audit opinion that an auditing firm can provide to a school district. Rehmann Robson, LLC has completed the annual audit of the District's financial statements of governmental activities, each major fund of the District, and the aggregate remaining fund information of Fruitport Community Schools for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. The clean, unmodified opinion of the District's auditing firm represents the District's continued commitment to safeguarding and appropriately allocating and utilizing taxpayer funds.

In the auditing firm's assessment of the District's internal control over financial reporting and internal control over major programs, no material weaknesses, nor significant deficiencies were noted in the audit. In addition, zero (0) audit findings were reported, and no non-compliance material to the financial statements were noted. The District continues to qualify as a low-risk auditee, and is committed to the highest fiscal standard. The District continues to be extremely thankful for the trust that the community has in the District, and shares this information in an effort to maintain a high level of trust as the District allocates and utilizes taxpayer funds.
