SCHOOL MILLAGE

You will never pay more than 6.9 mils per year, but the time will be extended many more years. You'll be paying for the rest of your life and extending the debt to the next owner of your house! The only way your taxes will go up for the school bonds is if you have an increased property evaluation, which happens regularly.

When do we say stop! Many seniors right now struggle to pay their property taxes. Sure, they can beg the government for a Hardship Exemption based on their income, but many will not do that and try to pay their 'fair share'. Even though this is a bond, it is added to your property taxes and you are obligated. If you can't pay it, your property can be forclosed upon. Is this what we want for our seniors? Is this what we want for anybody?

A new elementary school would be nice, but where do we draw the line? Let's pay off what we have now, or let some wealthy persons contribute to the new school. Not everybody is in the same pay bracket!

Doesn't the school have other sources of income? What about the casino bonuses? What about the new commercial buildings being built? Where else do their funds come from?

If you've already voted, you can go to the township to change it.

VOTE NO!

Pay off what we have from 2010, 2016, & 2021! The last BOND ends in 2049! No increased amount - just another extension for added years!
